The 2025 IEEE PES 35th Australasian Universities Power Engineering Conference (AUPEC) welcomes you to contribute to the 2025 Conference.

The conference invites researchers, students and industry professionals to submit new and original ideas on different aspects of power engineering, which includes but is not limited to the following broad topics:

- Power system generation, planning and operation
- Power system stability and control
- Resiliency of power grids
- Power system protection
- Power system communications
- Power electronics converters
- Power quality and harmonics
- Electrical machines and drives
- Power engineering education
- Electricity market and economics
- Renewable energy resources and their integrations
- Energy storage systems and their integrations
- Distributed and consumer energy resources
- Demand side management
- Virtual power plants
- Microgrids (DC, AC and hybrid)
- Multi-carrier energy systems, including hydrogen
- Asset management and condition monitoring of electrical plants
- Cyber security of power systems
- Electrification of transportation (EV, heavy vehicles and charging infrastructures)
- Data analytics and AI in power systems
- FACTS and HVDC
- Impacts of climate changes on the energy sector
- Energy transition

Preparation and Formatting Requirements <u>Stream 1 - Full paper</u>

- Full paper submissions should be limited to 5 pages.
- Format of the paper is available here: <u>https://ieee-pes.org/publications/authors-kit/preparation-of-a-formatted-conference-paper/</u>
- Final Paper Submission Deadline: 15 August 2025

Stream 2 - Abstract submission

- Abstract should be limited to 1 page. The following information should be included in the abstract- Tile, Authors, affiliations, Impact of the study.
- Format of the abstract: Body Time s New Roman Font 10, single column, single line space; Title Bold, Time s New Roman Font 24, single column, single line space; Authors/affiliations : Time s New Roman Font 11, double column, single line spacing

Instructions For Abstract Submissions

- 1. Login to Evexus: <u>https://ieeeaupec-</u> <u>c10000.eorganiser.com.au/index.php?r=site/login</u>
- 2. Click the "Create an Author Account" button and enter your contact details. These details are required to create the account. Once you have created an account within this portal you can proceed with your submissions.
- 3. Once you have logged into the submission portal, click the 'Submit' button and select either an Abstract or Full Paper submission to access the submission page.
- 4. You will be required to provide the following details prior to submitting:
 - a. Indicate your preferred presentation type.
 - b. Enter your paper title in the 'Paper Title' box.
 - c. Upload the PDF file that contains your Abstract or Full Paper, following the above specifications.
 - d. Add any additional emails to the email correspondence box (any email addresses entered here will be included in the correspondence emails that are sent to you).
 - e. Enter the name and organisation of all co-presenters and co-authors.
 - f. Ensure you indicate the presenting author(s) for the abstract and include a brief biography. The biography should be no more than 100 words.
 - g. Select the most relevant theme for your abstract.



Other Information

All papers/abstracts will be peer-reviewed, and accepted papers/abstract will be included in the conference proceedings. Full papers that were presented in person by one of the authors in the conference will only be published in IEEE Xplore. There is a limit of 2 submissions per registration.

There will be awards for student's paper, which will be announced later. These awards will be exclusively for the IEEE PES student Members. First named author must be an enrolled student from a university for eligibility of these awards.

General Policies and Requirements

- All papers must be original unpublished work.
- Work must be submitted to the Conference Managers via Evexus **by 30 May 2025**.
- All required fields on the online abstract submission form must be completed.

IEEE POLICIES

IEEE reserves the right to exclude a paper from distribution after the conference (e.g., by not including it in IEEE Xplore) if the paper is not presented at the conference.

The conference organisers suggest that if an author is unable to present the paper at the conference in person, a substitute presenter should be arranged (for example, a colleague who will attend the conference).

Papers are reviewed on the basis that they do not contain plagiarised material and have not been submitted to any other conference at the same time (double submission). These matters are taken very seriously, and IEEE will act against any author who has engaged in either practice.
