1. Introduction

1.1. Competition Title: T-Shirt Design Challenge

1.2. Competition Description

Participants are encouraged to submit designs for the official SAC 2020 t-shirt. This challenge occurs much earlier in the year than other competitions, due to the need to print shirts with the winning design. Rather than having a company design the logo, the SAC planning committee has decided to continue the tradition that attendees of the conference will design, submit, and vote for their favorite t-shirt design. The t-shirt design submitted should incorporate relevant themes into it, like IEEE, UMBC, Electrical Engineering, Computer Science, the SAC, and/or the SAC competitions.

2. <u>Participant Eligibility</u>

2.1. IEEE Membership

All participants shall be registered IEEE student members attending the university they identified when registering for the SAC.

2.2. Team Composition

Teams are not allowed for this competition. All submissions shall be the work of one participant. Graduate students may participate in this competition.

2.3. Number of Teams

There is no limit to the number of individual participants that one university may register for this competition.

3. <u>Design Requirements</u>

3.1. Required Content

The submitted design shall include the phrase "SAC20", "SAC2020", "SAC 20" or "SAC 2020" in a legible format. Each submitted design must have a unique name, and be an original design. The submitted design shall only use the front of the t-shirt, and will only consist of two colors; one for the base color of the shirt, one for the submitted design.

3.2. Recommended Content

The submitted design is encouraged to incorporate the following topics:

- IEEE, its logo, and its materials.
- UMBC, its logo, and its mascot.
- Electrical Engineering, Computer Science, or any related major.
- the SAC, and/or the SAC competitions

3.3. Prohibited Content

The submitted design shall not infringe upon any copyrights, nor shall it include profanity, offensive language, or offensive graphics. The T-Shirt Design Challenge committee reserves the right to withhold any design deemed inappropriate.

4. <u>Submission Guidelines</u>

4.1. Number of Submissions

Each participant is limited to one submission. If multiple submissions are found, only the most recently-submitted design will be considered.

4.2. Submission Format

A digital upload (i.e. PDF, JPEG, PNG) of the finished design is required, and must be submitted through the submission link on the SAC 2020 website.

4.3. Submission Deadline

The deadline for the t-shirt submission shall be provided on the SAC 2020 website.

4.4. Voting Process

Registered conference attendees will have the opportunity to vote for their favorite design electronically, from a set of approved designs.
