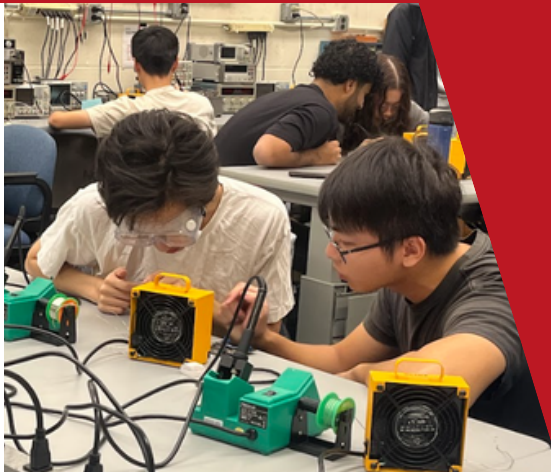

Competition Sponsorships

Micromouse Competition – \$250+

One of IEEE's flagship events, the Micromouse Competition challenges students to create an autonomous maze-solving robot. Combining elements of robotics, programming, and hardware, they will compete for the fastest time to complete the maze provided.

Sumo Bot Competition – \$250+

Inspired by Japanese sumo wrestling, the Sumo Bot Competition challenges teams to design, build, and program their own autonomous robots and compete to be the last one standing. The robots are designed to push their opponent out of a circular ring, while adhering to a weight and size requirement.

Mini Pupper – \$250+

The Mini Pupper Competition is a challenge aimed at building and programming autonomous robots designed to follow a predefined path marked on a surface and perform dance routines synced to music. Competitors will demonstrate their robots' ability to speedily follow the path accurately while navigate around obstacles.

Brown Bag Competition – \$250+

Putting students' circuit skills to the test, the Brown Bag Competition tasks participants to complete circuit challenges in a laboratory setting. Teams of 1-4 participants will be provided electrical components along with their datasheets and apply their electronics knowledge and problem-solving abilities to build a functional device or solution.

Competition Sponsorship Levels (Cont.)

Ethics Competition – \$250+

The IEEE Student Ethics Competitions (SECs) are endorsed by the IEEE Ethics and Member Conduct Committee (EMCC). Participants work in teams to analyze a case study, propose solutions, and present their findings to a panel of judges, emphasizing the importance of ethical considerations in professional practice.

Project Showcase – \$250+

The Project Showcase Competition is a platform for individuals or teams to present their innovative engineering and technology projects. The competition allows participants to demonstrate their technical expertise, creativity, and problem-solving skills while gaining recognition for their work.

Paper Competition – \$250+

The Paper Competition invites individuals or teams to submit their innovative engineering and technology projects in the form of research, ideas, or reports. The competition allows participants to present their ideas to be graded anonymously and overviewed by a qualified committee member.
